



Winter in the Bay 2023: Coming Home

You're invited to participate in the third annual Winter in the Bay art exhibit and writing contest.

Works of art by members of the Peggy's Cove Area Festival of the Arts Society will be on display at the SMB Community Enterprise Centre and online. **This year, the exhibit period begins in January. Works will be on display from Monday, January 23 to Friday, February 24.** (Please note: your PCAFA membership must be up to date for you to participate.)

Local writers will submit short non-fiction essays (max. 350 words) or short fiction (max. 2,500 words) to the writing contest. Each piece of writing submitted must use as illustration or inspiration one of the works in the art exhibit. The deadline to submit an essay is Friday, February 17, and the deadline to submit a short story is Friday, March 10.

This year's specific theme, Coming Home, may be interpreted as broadly as participating artists wish, provided the work can be linked in some way with the themes of winter and home. You're encouraged to interpret the theme creatively, to help inspire the writers! Many writers of past submissions have told us their essays and stories were directly inspired by the art you shared.

Because of limited space at the Community Enterprise Centre, participating artists will be accepted on a first-come basis. **We will hold a spot for requesting artists, as space permits, any time from now to January 12, provided you submit the attached Details and Waiver by the deadline of January 12.** You can scan and email the documentation or drop it off at the CEC. There is an after-hours mail slot to the left of the front door.

Art can be in any medium. Two-dimensional and three-dimensional art can be included. 2D pieces should be no larger than 20x20 inches. Note that the 3D display shelves are 10" deep.

The deadline for submitting your request to be included in this year's Winter in the Bay art exhibit is Friday, January 13. With that request, please include details about the art you are submitting: your name, artwork title, size, medium, price (if for sale), and one or two sentences about the work and how it fits the theme. **Works must be dropped off at the Community Enterprise Centre Friday, January 20, between 9am and 4pm, unless you have made other arrangements with us.**

EXHIBIT RULES & ARTIST'S WAIVER

I, _____, the artist, agree to the following:

1. I am a current member of the Peggy's Cove Area Festival of the Arts Society.
2. I understand that works from the Winter in the Bay 2023: Coming Home art exhibit will be used by local writers to illustrate and/or inspire written nonfiction essays and short fiction, and I consent to an image of my artwork being used in this way.
3. The St. Margaret's Bay Community Enterprise Centre (CEC) shall exercise as much care in respect to the Artwork/Exhibit as it does in safeguarding its own property. Notwithstanding that, I acknowledge and agree that the St. Margaret's Bay Community Enterprise Centre will provide no additional security for the Artwork/Exhibit.
4. I acknowledge that my Artwork on display may be damaged, lost or stolen during the exhibition of or during the unpacking and packing of, and I acknowledge and understand the risk involved by allowing such Artwork to be displayed by the St. Margaret's Bay Community Enterprise Centre, located at Unit 1-5229 St. Margaret's Bay Road, Upper Tantallon, Nova Scotia, B3Z 4R5.
5. I understand that the CEC does not insure the Artwork/Exhibits.
6. The term of the exhibition begins when the Artwork/Exhibits are delivered to the CEC and shall run through the agreed upon exhibition end date, plus a period of no longer than two days after the exhibit period ends.
7. In the event of an emergency, The CEC has the absolute right, in its sole discretion, to remove or to relocate any Artwork, notifying the artist within 48 hours.
8. By signing this waiver, I hereby agree to indemnify and hold the St. Margaret's Bay Community Enterprise Centre, its Board of Directors, employees or designated representatives, harmless from any type of intellectual Artwork/Exhibit infringement, including but not limited to patent, copyright or trademark infringement.
9. The Artist/Exhibitor agrees to permit the CEC to use his/her name, contact information and/or photographic images of the artwork/exhibition on display at the CEC in promotional, including reproduction in any print media, reference materials, newsletters (its own or those of its clients), directories and on its website and/or Facebook page or those of its clients and to otherwise identify the Artist/Exhibitor with the CEC excluding the Artist/Exhibitor's confidential information, and for no other purpose.
10. I have read this Policy, Waiver and Release Form in its entirety and fully understand its contents. I have signed it voluntarily and of my own free will. By signing it, I release and hold harmless the St. Margaret's Bay Community Enterprise Centre, its Board of Directors, employees or representatives from and against any and all claims of injury or damages relating to the above provisions.
11. I agree to have the CEC collect payment on my behalf for sales of my work, if it is for sale, by cash or cheque, and 100% of this payment will be remitted to me.
